The Celebration Tree

The Partners of LaFetra Center for Seniors sponsors a unique program called **The Celebration Tree**, which provides an opportunity to recognize the support of the Partners Organization for Seniors. Through a pre-selected donation, an individual (or family) can select an engraved metallic leaf, which may include a special occasion, a family event or a special memory. This metallic leaf is then placed on the mural.

Located in the Sage Room of the LaFetra Center, the ten foot high **Celebration Tree** wall mural was painted by local artist Darrell Burchfield. Rita Scott, who at the time chaired the Partners of LaFetra, not only was involved in the tree selection, but was also responsible for the development and financial support of the Celebration Tree Program. In 2001 the Oak Tree Mural was dedicated and because of her generous support, Rita was recognized with a plaque which was placed on the trunk of the Celebration Tree.

The most recent addition to this wonderful tree mural was an identifying banner across the top of the tree. This banner was designed, and literally made by another one of our members, Penni Reilley, in memory of her late husband Bill.

Debbie Dozal, Human Services Superintendent, told us that the donations to Partners directly benefit the LaFetra Center, its programs, and senior services in Glendora.
