# **Glendora Kiwaniannes Leadership Academy Information Sheet**

## **What**

The Glendora Kiwaniannes, a not for profit volunteer organization affiliated with Kiwanis International, will host a five day, three-hour a day, **Leadership Academy** for students who have completed fifth grade in the Glendora or Charter Oak School District. The purpose of the Leadership Academy is to: *train and inspire young children to become leaders in their community and to teach them the skills necessary to do so.* This program is supported by the Arsalyn Foundation.

## **When and Where**

The Academy camp will be held Monday through Friday, June 13 – 17 from 9 a.m. to noon at the United Methodist Church located at 201 E. Bennett Avenue, Glendora, one block east of Glendora Avenue. *The Leadership Academy is not affiliated with the United Methodist Church.*

Only 32 students will be selected for the Academy and the applications of those not accepted will be returned. Students will be notified of their acceptance by May 25.

## **Why**

The three-hour a day program is focused on fifth graders as they transition from elementary school to middle school. Few leadership opportunities exist for this grade level but many opportunities to participate await them in middle and high school. Students should feel confident to participate in leadership roles after attending the Academy.

## **How**

The curriculum will be taught by the Glendora Kiwaniannes, many of them current or retired teachers and leaders in the community. Topics to be discussed are: What is a leader with visits from local leaders who will discuss their leadership roles in the community; What skills do leaders need will a focus on public speaking, problem solving, working together; How to be an informed and involved citizen with opportunities to learn about propaganda and the voting process.

All Academy students will receive a notebook and t-shirt. Snacks will be provided daily. The cost to participate is \$25.

## **HOW TO ENROLL**

To apply for the Leadership Academy, complete the application form and mail it with check by May 16 to the Glendora Kiwaniannes, P.O. Box 1953, Glendora, CA 91740. Students will be notified of their selection by May 25. Those students not accepted will receive a full refund.
